Council, Mr. Filer, and town staff held a budget work session specifically to review and discuss: 1) Trash/Recycle Contract - Updike; 2) Water/Sewer Hookup Fees; 3) Modification to Town Code Regarding Sale of Bulk Hookup Fees; 4) Budget Planning – Projects, Equipment, and Council Requests.

During the meeting the following action took place:

After a lengthy discussion regarding Council's displeasure with the Updike Service Contract, it was decided by Council (without a vote) to

5 Council then took the following action after a lengthy discussion  
6 regarding the Water/Sewer Hookup Fees and how to decrease town  
7 debt:

9 Council member Wade made the motion to change the ordinance  
10 regarding the prepayment of hookup fees; requesting that legal  
11 counsel review and update the ordinance to remove any outdated  
12 regulations that are no longer applicable or any references to  
13 prepayments. Council member Gehle seconded the motion. The  
14 vote went as follows: 4-0 in favor.

16 Council member Wade then made a second motion:

18 Council member Wade made the motion to change the Residential  
19 Water Hookup Rate to \$4780 and the Residential Sewer Hookup  
20 Rate to \$7720 for a total of \$12500 to take effect in FY 2016/17.  
21 Council member Carter seconded the motion. The vote went as  
22 follows: 4-0 in favor.
